Grading and Progress Reports

The District believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the student, and recognizes the responsibility to keep parents or legal guardians informed of student welfare and progress in school.

The issuance of grades and progress reports on a regular basis serves as the basis for continuous evaluation of the student's performance and determining changes that should be made to effect improvement. These reports shall be designed to provide information that will be helpful to the student, teacher, counselor, and parent or legal guardian.

The District directs the Superintendent to establish a system of reporting student progress and shall require all staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility. Staff members, parents or legal guardians, and teachers shall be involved.
