

Part-Time Attendance

As it is the desire of the Board to accommodate the educational needs of all students residing within its District boundaries who are not otherwise enrolled in an educational program, it shall be the policy of the District to allow such students to enroll on a part-time basis for academic classes in grades eleven through twelve, at the discretion of building administrator. The building administrator's discretion will be guided by, but not limited to, the following:

1. Space availability in classes desired (additional instructors will not be added to accommodate requests);
2. Registration will not preempt full-time students and, therefore, may be delayed to determine space available;
3. Students who have been denied full-time attendance for disciplinary, academic, or other reasons will not be admitted on a part-time basis;
4. Funding impact and/or other circumstances which may adversely affect other students;
5. Home-schooled students will not be admitted;
6. Part-time students shall enroll for two class periods (or its equivalent) per day.

Transportation for part-time students remains the sole responsibility of the student and/or parents. The Montana High School Association standards currently prohibit part-time students from participating in MHSA-sponsored activities at the high school level.
