CORVALLIS MIDDLE SCHOOL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

It is the belief of the administration and staff that participation in extracurricular programs is a privilege extended to you by your school. You will be representing your school and community. We expect you to have pride in yourself, your activity, and Corvallis Middle School. You will strive to be a good citizen at all time. These rules will cover the period from the first day of fall practice through/including the last day of school.

RULES:

1. Eligibility is taken every Monday.
 - a. Eligibility is based on the 4 core subjects (Math, Science, Lang. Arts, and Social Studies).
 - b. A student receiving an "F" in one of the core subjects will be assigned required study periods.
 - c. A student receiving an "F" in two or more of the core subjects will be on PROBATION. They will also be required to attend the study periods. While on PROBATION a student is allowed to practice and play in the activities.
 - d. A student receiving an "F" in two or more of the core subjects for the second week in a row will now become INELIGIBLE. They are still required to attend the study period. While INELIGIBLE a student is allowed to practice but NOT play in the activity.
 - e. Students are required to be on time and work productively during the study period. If late or not working it will NOT count as their assigned study period and therefore will not be allowed to participate in the next activity.
 - f. Any suspension during the week will result in ineligibility.
2. No use of, association with, or possession of substances banned in Corvallis School District policy. Examples of banned substances include those associated with tobacco, nicotine, alcohol, illegal drugs, and the intentional misuse of prescription drugs and other products.
 - a. 1st offense – The student may be suspended from all extracurricular activities for a period of 2 months from date of return to school.
 - b. 2nd offense – The student may be suspended from all extracurricular activities for a period of 6 months from date of return to school.
3. Attend School
 - a. You are required to be in school at least half a day in order to practice or participate in an event. This includes attendance after a morning practice session.
 - b. Should practice or competition fall on a holiday or weekend, you must be in attendance the last day of school prior to the activity.
4. Follow all school related policies as stated in the student handbook.
5. Each coach may have additional guidelines for his/her participants to follow during the season.
