Pole Vault Skills Camp



This camp will serve the beginning pole-vaulter. Athletes will be given basic skills, and advanced techniques to work on to become better at the vault.

Facilitated by three successful high school coaches, this five day camp will provide a substantial time period to hone skills and learn new ones.

The camp will be held at the Corvallis Community Events Center Track and Field facility, and will feature two pits, each reserved for different drills and techniques.

Junior High athletes will be given the afternoon time slot, and will hit the ground running at 2:00pm and will end at 4:30pm every day.

Video will be taken of each athlete and specific insight and techniques will be offered based on individual skills and habits.

Cost: A fifteen dollar facility use charge will apply.

Coaches:



Spencer Huls: Coach Huls is in his fourteenth year as head track and field coach for Corvallis High School, and for several of those years has been the primary pole vault coach there. He's worked with such successful athletes as Austin Byron and Katelyn Frost, both of which hold school record at CHS



Robert Leever: Robert has worked closely with young people in his long career in the military, and has coached high school pole vault at Mitchell Nebraska. He was also a successful high school vaulter and cleared a height of 15'4".

Aaron Carmody: Coach Carmody has been the Vault coach at Hamilton High School for the past nine years, and in that time has coached multiple state placers. Coach Carmody's athletes have vaulted near school record heights, and have been extremely competitive at the state level.
